

Covid-19 Visitor Information

The health and safety of our visitors is our top priority at CTF and the Construction Futures Centre.

To meet the WA Government requirements and medical health advice, CTF have a Covid - 19 Safety plan in place and have implemented the following measures to provide and maintain a safe environment for our visitors.

The following measures will be in place to safeguard the health of our visitors:

- Frequent cleaning to all touchable surfaces in the Construction Futures Centre.
- Touchless hand sanitiser stations and sanitising wipes that have been placed around the Construction Futures Centre for employees and visitors to use during their time at the venue.
- All visitors will need to sign in using the SafeWA app or complete a secure paper-based contact register upon arrival. We will require their name, phone number, date, and arrival time. This a mandatory requirement of the WA Government and Department of Health to assist with contact tracing if required.

- We ask that if you or someone in your group feel unwell, stay home, and visit us when you/they are better.
