### CTF Capital Grant Program 2026–27 – Applications Now Open

The Construction Training Fund (CTF) has opened applications for its 2026-27 Capital Grant Program, with \$10 million available to support eligible private Registered Training Organisations (RTOs) across Western Australia.

The program funds projects that expand training capacity, modernise delivery and strengthen industry outcomes.

#### Priority areas include:

- Growing the skilled workforce (housing and clean energy)
- Increasing apprenticeships and workforce retention
- Improving diversity and participation
- Supporting modern construction methods
- Expanding regional and remote training access.

Funding will be allocated based on demonstrated organisational need and the extent to which proposed projects contribute to strengthening Western Australia's construction training system.
